- 1. Isaiah 30:19-22
 - a. What stands out to you in these passages? (Feel free to read above and below the text to establish context.)
- 2. 1 Kings 19:7-18
 - a. When Elijah was in the cave and heard God's voice, what did he hear?
 - b. What is the message for us? (In the spirit of what we are trying to learn here, try not to use your brain only....Ask the Lord for insight. Slow down, pause...meditate....listen deeply...center down...and write down what comes to mind.)
- 3. John 10:1-6
 - a. What does Jesus say regarding His voice and His sheep?
- 4. 1 Cor. 2:1-16
 - a. What is the promise of verses 10 and 12?
 - b. What is the message being communicated to us in verses 10 and 12?
 - c. Contrast the message of this chapter with John 5:36-47. Why couldn't (wouldn't?) Jesus' hearers in John 5 believe and understand, even though they studied the scriptures (v. 39)? What was their problem?
- 5. Psalm 25:1-22
 - a. In vv. 4-14, describe the relationship between God and man and the role of two-way communication.
 - b. Who are the recipients of these "verbs of God"?
- 6. As you allow the sauce of God's word to soak into the meat of your mind and heart (remember that profound marinating analogy?), what do you think is the Lord's desire when it comes to communication with you, and his chosen ones?
- 7. Heb. 8:8-12 What do you think is meant by v. 11?
